

Medicaid Billing

The MO HealthNet Division provides monthly Medicaid Billing training sessions. These training sessions are an on-line interactive conference with the trainer. This allows training to a small group which provides more one-on-one time with the trainer.

If you have already submitted or are planning to submit in the near future a proposal for contract to provide in-home services, you must attend an on-line Medicaid Billing training session prior to the offer of a Participation Agreement for Home and Community Based Services.

You can either schedule the training now or wait until a later date when you are closer to having a contract in place. The sessions are limited to 10 internet connections per session. Only one internet connection per agency is allowable although there can be any number of staff in the room to attend the training.
